

CLIFTON BEACH TENNIS, PICKLE AND PADDLE RULES

- The Clifton Beach Racquet Courts are for the sole use of: Clifton Park residents; Clifton Lagoon residents; and Clifton Club members; and their guests; according to the established Clifton Beach rules for members and guests. See 2026 Clifton Beach Rules posted separately.
- The asphalt courts are for Tennis and Pickleball use only. The Paddle courts are for Paddle use only.
- All players, residents and visitors to the area shall exhibit courteous, respectful court etiquette at all times, i.e., wear proper attire with shirts required for men, court shoes only, exhibit respectful behavior toward others, refrain from using profanity, and no glass containers on court. All players shall follow established Beach parking rules.
- The Tennis courts are known as T1 and T2, and the Pickleball courts are to be known as P1 and P2, as shown below. (The Paddle court is next to them. See Map on last page.)
- The Tennis courts are known as T1 and T2, and the Pickleball courts are to be known as P1 and P2, as shown below. (The Paddle court is next to them. See Map on last page.)
- Tennis and Pickleball Court hours are from 8:00 AM to dusk.
- Members should hold open no more than two (2) Court reservations at a time; for Tennis Courts, that means one reservation for one day, and a second reservation for a different day; for Pickleball Courts that can mean both courts on the same day. In short, a single member cannot reserve both T1 and T2 at the same time but can reserve both P1 and P2 at the same time.
- Play is limited to two hours. If there are no players waiting, players on the court may continue to play beyond the allotted time until another group arrives. At that time, they shall turn the court over to the new group.
- The Paddle court is next to the tennis and pickleball courts. Paddle court hours are currently 8:00 AM to 9:30 PM weeknights, and 10:00 PM Friday and Saturday nights.
- Players shall dispose of all trash upon leaving the courts. Trash cans will either be available at courtside or just outside the courts.
- Members may arrange private lessons on the courts subject to the same reservation

rules as above. No more than four members, including guests and a coach, may occupy one T1 or T2 court for a tennis lesson. No more than four members, including guests and a coach, may occupy one P1 or P2 court for a pickleball lesson. Courts can only be reserved for lessons by the beneficiary or member receiving the lesson. No coach can reserve the courts for a lesson, whether a beneficiary, lagoon resident, or Club member. Violation of this reservation rule will result in immediate revocation of court access to beneficiaries for the season, permanent revocation of court usage for Lagoon residents, and permanent revocation of court and beach privileges for Club members.

- Rule violations may result in penalties by the Clifton Park Trustees, including loss of court and/or beach privileges.
- Signage should be posted with this message:
- Courts are not maintained. All players shall play on or around the Courts at their own risk. Neither the Clifton Park trustees, the Clifton Lagoon nor the Clifton Club are responsible for any loss or injury arising from play on these Courts
